

## **Israel Warns Syria On Golan Heights**

JERUSALEM (WNS) Two Cabinet Ministers warned Syria not to undertake any "adventures" toward recapturing the Golan Heights nor to assume that its hope to achieve strategic parity with Israel could ever lead to Israel's military defeat.

At the same time, however, Deputy Premier and Minister of Housing and Construction David Levy invited both Syria and King Hussein of Jordan to sit down with Israel and rationally talk about peace.

Levy, who was addressing the International Israel Bonds 35th anniversary conference here, rejected an international conference to deal with peace between Israel and its two Arab neighbors. He said it was in-



UNITED NATIONS (WNS) — Benjamin Netanyahu, Israel's Ambassador to the United Nations. examined the file on former UN Secretary **General Kurt Waldheim** at the UN archives here and said afterwards that the contents of the file indicated that the matter of Waldheim's alleged Nazi past cannot be "laid to rest."
