The name change was the result of several months of curricular review by President Paulus that will allow Las Vegas Business College to grant Associates degrees while continuing to offer various short term studies that lead to rapid job placement. Barbara, as she insists on being called by students and faculty-alike, is assisted by Vicki Christenson, who administers student loans and grants. Both Vicki and Barbara were the recipients of Masters degrees in Education from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, in June of 1985.

Catholic, Jewish Groups Plan Program To Teach Holocaust

NEW YORK (WNS) — The American Jewish Committee and the National Conference of Catholic Bishops have announced plans to develop a program to teach Catholic students about the Holocaust. The three-year project will include developing programs for parochial schools, Catholic colleges, seminary training and parish education. It will be directed by Eugene J. Fisher, executive secretary of the NCCB Secretariat for Catholic-Jewish Relations in Washington, and Rabbi A. James Rudin, national interreligious affairs

director of the American Jewish Committee. Sister Carol Rittner of Mercy College, Detroit, will be project coordinator.

Fischer said the project planners hope to develop a balanced, sensitive program that will help students "confront evil better and be drawn to the good." He said many Catholic schools around the country already have begun studies of the Holocaust and that the new joint program will draw on a survey of their experiences. U.S. Catholics have a mandate from Pope John Paul II to study the Holocaust, Fischer added, as reported by the NCNS.

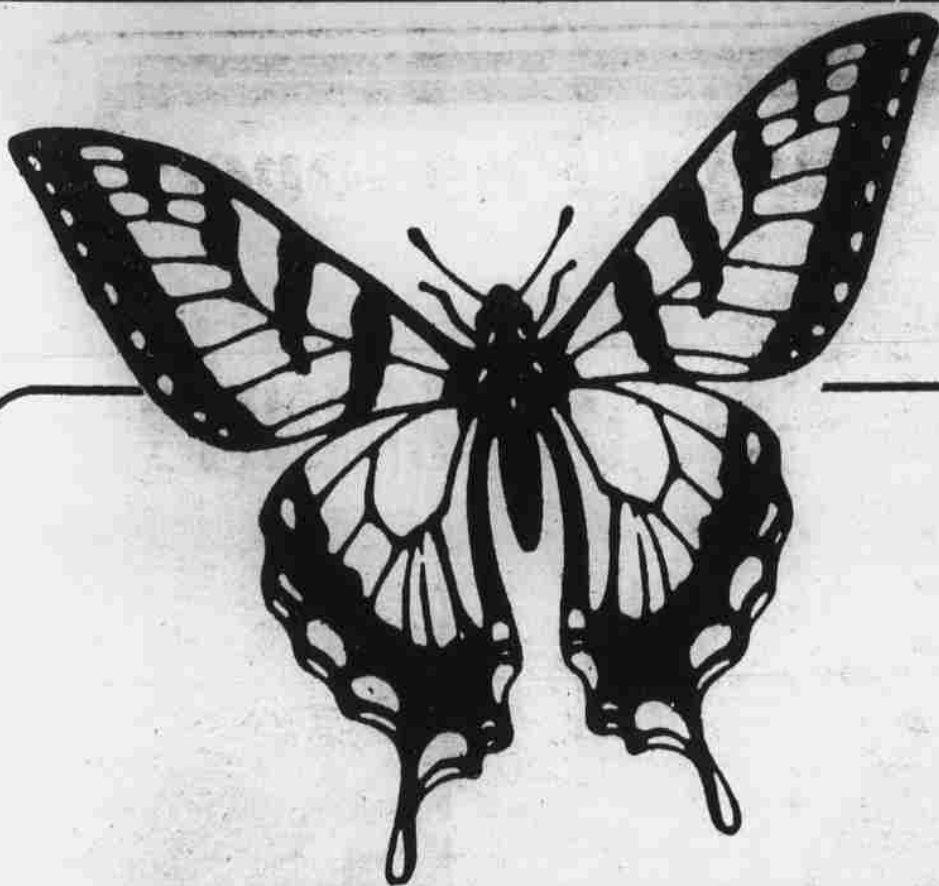
