Dimitri Gurevich Wins U.S. Chess Open At Imperial Palace

More than 700 chess players including Grandmasters packed the convention area of the Imperial Palace Hotel & Casino, recently, for the 1986 National Open Chess Tournament. The National Open was co-sponsored by the United States Chess Federation and Imperial Palace.

Play began Friday at 12:30 and continued past midnight all three days. The final round ended at 2:00 a.m. Only one player, Grandmaster Kamran Shirazi, had won every game in the first five rounds for a score of 5. Four players had accumulated 4-1/2 points each (four wins and a draw). When Dmitri Gurevich defeated Shirazi, and the other three players with 4-1/2 points also won their matches, it was a four way tie for first place. The U.S. Chess Federation broke the tie by looking over those four players' records, awarding the trophy to Gurevich, a Grandmaster from Brooklyn, N.Y. (formerly of the U.S.S.R). GM Sergey Kudrin is also a Soviet emigre, now a Stanford, CT. resident. The other two winners were International Master (IM) Joe Bradford of Austin, TX. and GM Walter Browne of Berkeley, CA. Browne has been the national champion six times

Thursday evening, a "Blitz" was held as a preliminary to the actual tournament. Twenty-four players played games lasting ten minutes total, five minutes for each player. After many elimination matches, IM Joel Benjamin of Brooklyn was the winner. Benjamin, who is 22 years old, won the Masters Invitational in Chicago one week before the National Open at the Imperial Palace.

This is the second year the National Open has been at the Imperial Palace, and the tournament is returning in March, 1987. Total prize money was \$17,000, a record for the event.
