JERUSALEM (WNS) — Secretary of State George Shultz may visit Israel in the next few months for another try at reviving the stalemated Middle East peace process, Cabinet Secretary Yossi Beilin told reporters here.

He spoke after the Cabinet session at which Premier Shimon Peres briefed the ministers on his four-day visit to the U.S. which included meet-

ings with Shultz and with Vice President George Bush. Bush accepted Peres' invitation to visit Israel this spring, although no date was set.
