

## Kibbutz In Israel: A Summer Of Adventure

"It was very valuable for me, since I toughened up -- both mentally and physically, and the cross-cultural experience was fascinating." These are the thoughts of Sandra Goldberg of Manhattan, a graduate of the Short Summer Ulpan program in Israel who addressed a group of potential program participants recently at the Kibbutz Aliya Desk offices.

Short Summer Ulpan is one of several programs offered to North American students and young adults by Kibbutz Aliya Desk, an organization responsible for promotion of programs for all kibbutz movements in Israel.

"I had an excellent teacher," continued Sandra, "I learned more than a semester's worth in two months. Now, I'm conversationally fluent and am taking an advanced modern Hebrew language course."

College students and young adults can take part in the Short Summer Ulpan, a ten-week program open to anyone between the ages of 18 and 27. The first eight weeks takes place on a kibbutz, with participants spending five hours a day working alongside kibbutz members and two

hours a day at Hebrew class and lectures.

Three Short Summer Ulpan programs will be offered this year, starting on May 21st, June 11th and June 25th.

Other programs offered by the Kibbutz Aliya Desk this summer include "Summer in Kibbutz and Jerusalem" (in conjunction with the Hebrew University - for four-six collect credits); "Project: Discovery," which includes a Kibbutz experience,

an archaeological dig, and a "follow-the-Bible" tour. Those persons wishing to do straight Kibbutz volunteer work may apply either as individuals or join a volunteer group through the Kibbutz Aliya Desk's Temporary Worker section.
