Israel's First Test-Tube Baby Born

TEL AVIV (WNS) — tubes from newly-Israel's first test-tube fertilized eggs, were frozen gradually by embryo -- and only the fifth such birth in the world -- was delivered by caesarean section at the Sheba government hospital at Tel Hashomer.

Both the daughter and 30-year-old mother, Nilli Arad, were reported to be doing extremely well.

According to Prof. Shlomo Mashiach, head of the Sheba Obstetrics Department, Israel was only the third country in which frozen embryos had been successfully re-implanted, after four other births in Melbourne, Australia, and Cambridge, England.

He explained that the embryos, raised in test-

minus 180 celsius, and then kept in liquid nitrogen for as long as required.

The Arads have been trying to have a child

for seven years, using various fertility procedures. An earlier attempt to implant a frozen embryo had failed.
