as war criminals. Waldheim served in Yugoslavia and in Greece, and was one of only 34 German officers to receive an Ustashi (Croatian) medal.

MYTH -- Throughout World War II, Kurt Waldheim showed a loathing of Nazi thought and ideology.

FACT -- In 1944, Waldheim submitted his 94page doctoral dissertation on Konstantin Frantz, the 19th century forerunner to National Socialism - a topic certainly consistent with the approved academic "guidelines" of the day.

MYTH -- Kurt Waldheim never knew about the deportation of Jews from Greece until he was questioned about the matter by a New York Times reporter in late March of 1986.

FACT -- Kurt Waldheim was an interpreter to the general staff of the Wermacht command in Yugoslavia. In that capacity, he signed off daily on intelligence reports. At one time, his command was stationed five miles outside of Salonica. It is inconceivable to even many of Waldheim's defenders that a man of his sophistication and rank would not be aware of the deportation of
