Two Terrorists Killed

TEL AVIV (WNS) — Three Israel Defense Force soldiers were wounded seriously in a clash in the eastern sector of south Lebanon in which two terrorists were killed.

"One Man Plus The Truth Constitutes A Majority"

Kurt Waldheim - The Shame Behind The Myth

FACT -- Kurt Waldheim is a monumental liar whose trail of deceit makes Richard Nixon's Watergate look like child's play.

MYTH -- Kurt Waldheim writes in his autobiographies "The Challenge of Peace" and "The Eye of the Storm" that his unit was moved into occupied active combat on the Eastern Front in 1941; "I was wounded in the leg and medically discharged. By the time I was repatriated in 1942, it became impossible to leave the country. The borders had been closed and were being heavily patrolled.. I was permitted to resume my studies toward a doctorate in law which I obtained some two years later."

FACT -- Kurt Waldheim was never discharged from the army. He first distinguished himself in the service of Hitler's army starting in 1942. He served on the command staff of two Wehrmacht generals, General Alexander von Loehr and Major General Stahl, both of whom were hanged as war criminals. Waldheim served in Yugoslavia and in Greece, and was one of only 34 German officers to receive an Ustashi (Croatian) medal.

MYTH -- Throughout World War II, Kurt Waldheim showed a loathing of Nazi thought and ideology.

FACT -- In 1944, Waldheim submitted his 94-page doctoral dissertation on Konstantin Frantz, the 19th century forerunner to National Socialism - a topic certainly consistent with the approved academic "guidelines" of the day.

MYTH -- Kurt Waldheim never knew about the deportation of Jews from Greece until he was questioned about the matter by a New York Times reporter in late March of 1986.

FACT -- Kurt Waldheim was an interpreter to the general staff of the Wehrmacht command in Yugoslavia. In that capacity, he signed off daily on intelligence reports. At one time, his command was stationed five miles outside of Salonica. It is inconceivable to even many of Waldheim's defenders that a man of his sophistication and rank would not be aware of the deportation of
