
Reno Rabbi Establishes United Jewish Congress



Rabbi Dr. C. Joseph Teichman is the religious leader of Temple Emanu-El in Reno, Nevada. Rabbi Teichman has recently established the United Jewish Congress, an organization dedicated to mobilizing and synthesizing Jewish and Christian efforts to oppose bigotry and intolerance and to foster understanding between these two great faiths of the western world.

Rabbi Teichman, a religious leader ordained by an orthodox rabbinical seminary and affiliated with the Conservative Movements Rabbinical Assembly, has been in communication with Dan Rather, distinguished correspondent of C.B.S. News, about the farm crisis, and the anti-Semitic literature distributed by such groups as the "Klan" and the Aryan Nations. This literature has been making such libelous and spurious claims as the involvement of Jewish bankers with the conglomerates that are foreclosing on land being held by many of the bankrupt farmers. The Rabbi is intending to tour parts of the farm belt, Minnesota, Iowa, Kansas, etc. As their


