B'nai B'rith Urges U.S. Justice Department To Put Waldheim On 'Watch List'

WASHINGTON — B'nai B'rith International urged the U.S. Justice Department to place former United Nations Secretary-General Kurt Waldheim on the government's "watch list." This would bar him from the United States while the Justice Department investigated his alleged activities with the German Nazis.

In a letter to Attorney General Edwin Meese, Gerald Kraft, B'nai B'rith president, said "there can be no question" that Waldheim, who is the leading candidate for the presidency of Austria, misrepresented his World War II record.

"The evidence to date shows incontrovertibly that he had direct knowledge of Nazi persecution and played an administrative role in arrying it out," said Kraft.

Weber Lauds Rejection Of Saudi Arms Sale

WASHINGTON — U.S. Rep. Vin Weber (2nd-Minn.), a leader among the House Republicans to defeat the proposed Saudi Arabian arms sale, hailed the landslide defeat of the arms sale as exceeding expectations and predicted the Congress will overturn a presidential veto.

"I believe this has been a great victory for U.S. foreign policy objectives in the Middle East. Saudi Arabia simply does not have a track record of supporting the peace process between Israel and its Arab neighbors. This should certainly be a necessary condition for any arms sale in the volatile Middle East," Weber said.

Weber joined Rep. Mel Levine (D. Calif.) in leading a coordinated bipartisan effort to get House members to support H. J. Res. 589, the resolution opposing the Saudi arms sale.
