How does NED DAY know if its a hot show or not?...BILL PECCOLE has put together a development joint venture by Arizona-based WESTERN DEVCOR INC. & Wisconsin-based JOHNSON WAX DEVELOPMENT CORP. and some of his own finances for a multimillion dollar project called NEVADA FINANCIAL CENTER on the northwest corner of Sahara Blvd. & Rancho...Caesars Palace private jet flew real estate developer J. PAUL FOX from his Malibu villa with celebs TIA CARRERE ("General Hospital," "The A-Team"), socialite IRENE HEIDT, ADRIANNA KEAGI (rock group KID CREOLE's THE COCONUTS) and

other posh people, for "Lifestyles of the Rich and Famous," lensing a CP sumptuous repast in the Bacchanal Room, with ROBIN LEACH to voice-over for a July airing. 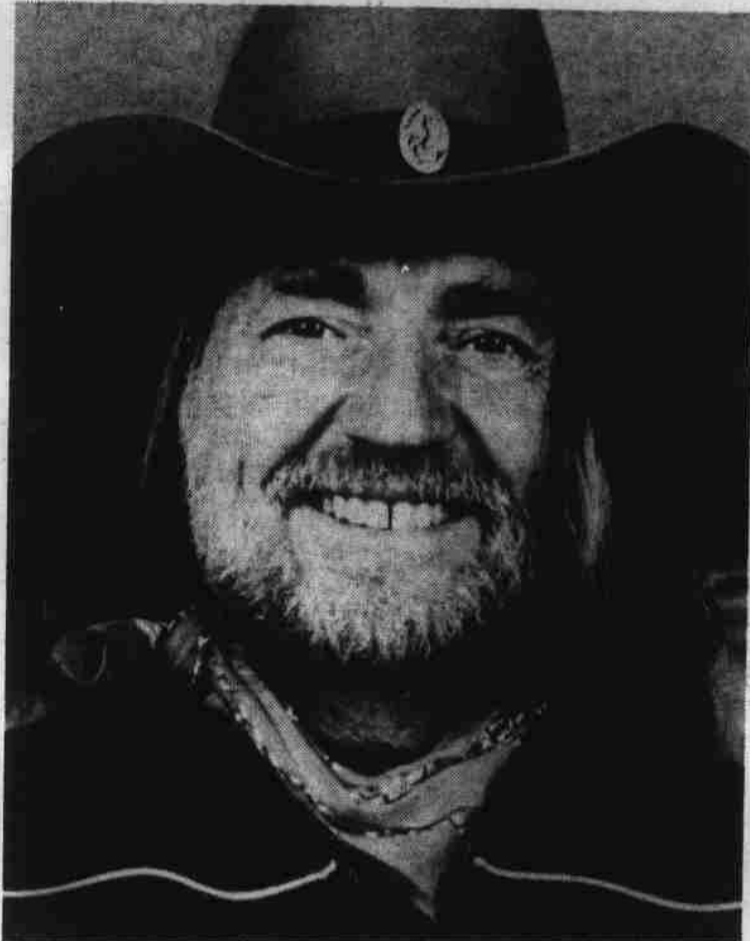

Meanwhile the new star policy starts Friday with DONNA SUMMER and impressionist LOUISE DUART. DUARTZ is one of MITZI SHORE's Comedy Store faithfuls appearing many times at the Dunes. The lineup for the Comedy Store this week is TAMAYO ITSUKI, STEVE OEDEKIRK, SAM KINISON and ANGEL SALAZAR...Ready for their Las Vegas Hilton date June 3 are DIAHANN CARROLL and, in his first single shot here, MAURICE HINES. Costar is KRISTIE ALLEY as lounge singer fem interest.

Willie Nelson, Waylon Jennings, Jessi Colter Perform Outdoor Concert At Caesars Palace June 7



Three of the brightest stars in Texas -- Willie Nelson, Waylon Jennings and Jessi Colter -- will sparkle in Las Vegas on Saturday, June 7, when Caesars Palace hosts a musical salute to the 150th anniversary of the Lone Star State.

The trio has worked together on various projects for more than a decade. Willie's first million-seller was the album "Wanted: The Outlaws," a compilation of his songs

and those of Waylon, Jessi and country music singer Tompall Glaser. "Outlaws" was the first Nashville-produced album to go platinum (one million copies sold). The title was a play on the stylistic independence that set Nelson and Jennings apart from their contemporaries in Nashville, many of whom dubbed Jennings a "Nashville rebel" in the '60s and "outlaw" in the '70s. Jennings' first single

to hit number one on "Billboard" charts was the title song from his album "This Time," which was co-produced by Nelson. Nelson and Jennings shared a Grammy in 1978 for their duo "Mamas Don't Let Your Babies Grow Up To Be Cowboys." Their album "Waylon and Willie" sold more than two million copies.

More recently, Nelson, Jennings and Colter completed filming the made-for-television version of the classic movie "Stagecoach." It was Jessi's acting debut, and was received so well that she now has a commitment to star with Robert Duvall in his self-produced tale of a Pentecostal minister and his family.

The outdoor concert at Caesars Palace marks the first time the trio has performed since the fundraiser "Farm Aid" last fall.
