In recent years, Salisbury has published "Without Fear of Favor: An Uncompromising Look at The New York Times;" "The Unknown War," an account of the German-Russian battles on the Eastern front during 1941-45; "Black Night, White Snow: Russia's Revolution 1905-17," and other books.
