Judge Earl White Files For Department 4

District Judge Earl White filed for the Department 4 position he has held for the last nine months.

White was appointed to the district court bench by Gov. Richard Bryan to fill the position left vacant by the death of Judge Tom O'Donnell.

Before his appointment White served for five years as a judge in Justice Court.

"It is my desire to make a career of the judiciary," White said. "I have been a hard working judge who has continually tried to expedite matters before my court. Hard work, judicial experience and dedication to the law will be my platform to retain my position."

White, 52, received his law degree magna cum laude from Howard University in 1963. He is a member of the American Bar Association, American Judicature Society and Association of Trial Lawyers of America.

He received the Amicus Curiae Award of the Nevada Judges Association, is a member of the American Judges Association and a member of the Merit Selection Panel, United States District Court.

White has served as assistant counsel for Southwest Gas Corporation and was Clark County deputy public defender from 1967 to 1969. He presently serves on the faculty of the National Judicial College.

He was legal advisor and special appeals officer for the Nevada Industrial Commission and hearing officer for the Nevada Equal Rights Commission. White also served as alternate referee for the Juvenile Department of the Eighth Judicial District Court.

White is married and the father of two children.
