117 Russian Jews To Re-Unite With Their Families In The U.S.

NEW YORK — Theodore Ellenoff, national president of the American Jewish Committee, issued the following statement:

"The American Jewish Committee welcomes the news that the Soviet Government has granted permission to 117 individuals to re-unite with their families in the United States. Family reunion is a precious humanitarian concept, and we share the joy of the reunited Christian and Jewish families in rejoining with their loved ones.

"We are concerned, however, that this Soviet action may turn out to be a gesture of limited significance.

"In the first four months of 1986, the USSR permitted an average of 70 Jews a month to emigrate. An increase of this number to 100 or 120 will do little to alleviate the plight of the 400,000 Jews seeking to leave. A marginal increase, welcome as it is, hardly compares to the average of 4,200 Jews leaving monthly in 1979.

"Only a significant change in Soviet policy -not sporadic gestures -- could help pave the way for a real improvement in relations between East and West."

The American Jewish Committee is this country's pioneer human relations organization. Founded in 1906, it combats bigotry, protects the civil and religious rights of Jews here and abroad, and advances the cause of improved human relations for all people everywhere.



Neo-Nazis Clash With Protesters In West Germany

BONN (WNS) — Nine persons, including four policemen were injured and 39 were arrested in a violent clash in Stuttgart between neo-Nazis and anti-Nazi protesters.

The street violence involved 150 delegates to the convention of the Freiheitliche Deutsche Arbeiterpartei (Free German Workers Party), one of the most active neo-Nazi groups in West Germany. They were battled by more than 500 anti-Nazis, including members of the Anti-Fascist League, the Green Party, Young Socialists, Communist Party and various trade unions.

Police said the combattants were armed with knives, truncheons, slingshots, whips and tear gas cannisters.
