academic institution, it is now ready to launch new programs and expand its scope of operations. The plan calls for: (1) increasing faculty salaries to retain the best qualified teachers and to attract additional instructors with superior qualifications and expertise, (2) building new facilities and renovating existing ones, (3) adding unique educational programs which will involve members of the business, legal and service communities. With the idea to cultivate an all encompassing intellectual environment that would give students a fuller appreciation of the value of education, (4) spending its considerable fund raising proceeds and grants to develop advanced courses of study for the gifted students and designing an overall enriched and innovative learning climate for all students and (5) obtaining national accreditation currently in process and due this year.

These components of the plan are all within the Academy's reach and several of the programs are scheduled to be implemented within the next 2 years.

To date, the Hebrew Academy is enjoying its largest registration ever, for this time of year, and the stability and morale of its faculty and personnel is at an all time high. The reason for this is fourfold: (a) The test scores (IOWA Tests of Basic Skills, hailed as an outstanding national test instrument in the 1985 "Buros' Mental Measurements") received this week places the Hebrew Academy students at the 96th percentile (1%ile rank above last years scores). (b) Most of the Academy's first crop of graduating students attending area high schools were placed at the top or near the top of the academic achievement scale. (c) The recent graduating students have had sufficient credits and overall academic achievement to graduate from the area public high schools two years ahead of their peers, and one year ahead at a private high school, and (d) Dr. Lewis of Nevada State Department of Education, at a recent board meeting, cited the Hebrew Academy as one of the most outstanding private institutions in the State.

Holocaust Must Never Happen Again, Donahue Tells 5,000 At Sutton Place

entire human race," award-winning talk-show host Phil Donahue told an overflow audience at Sutton Place Synagogue here this week that the trauma of the visit had renewed his commitment that "never again can mankind permit such an atrocity to occur."

Mr. Donahue, whose daily TV program has received 17 Emmy awards, was the guest of Rabbi David B. Kahane in the final program of the congregation's 1986 "Jewish Town Hall" series. Some 5,000 persons viewed the discussion in the main auditorium and on closed-circuit television in the synagogue ballroom and at nearby locations. Loudspeakers beamed the discussion to crowds gathered around the synagogue on Manhattan's Upper East Side.

A graduate of Catholic parochial schools and the University of Notre Dame, Donahue told the audience that demonstrations such as the recent outpouring of 300,000 persons in New York to celebrate Solidarity Day with Natan (Anatoly) Shcharansky were needed to bring about an easing of Soviet emigration policies and U.S. - USSR tensions.

"A summit meeting will be meaningless unless the situation of Soviet Jews is resolved," he added.

Like his NBC colleague Tom Brokaw, who spoke at the synagogue two week's earlier, Donahue defended the network's controversial interview with Arab terrorist Abul Abbas as "fulfilling the media's responsibility to present the truth." He stated:

"Terrorists have graced the covers of national magazines. If it's unfair for the electronic media it equally unfair for print journals."

Donahue added that the news media were running "wimpy and scared" of Washington officialdom and corporate oligarchies. "As the number of independent media outlets decreases, the opportunity for the press to make independent judgments on the news they will or won't cover is becoming increasingly restricted," he said, adding:

"When General Electric assumes control of NBC later this year, what kind of coverage would they give to another Chernobyl disaster? GE happens to be one of the country's biggest manufacturers of nuclear power generators."

Two Soviet Jews Sentenced To Three-Year Prison Terms In Soviet Union

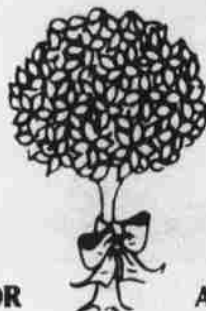
NEW YORK (WNS) — Twenty-seven year-old Moscow refusenik

Alexi Magarik was sentenced to three years in prison for alleged "drug possession" by a Tbilisi court, the Student Struggle for Soviet Jewry reported here. His appeal will be within ten days.

According to the SSSJ, Magarik, who is a cellist and Hebrew teacher, was arrested in a move the SSSJ described as "a bold attempt by the KGB to terrorize other Jewish educators."

The SSSJ and the Long Island Committee for Soviet Jewry also reported that Prisoner of Conscience Dr. Vladimir Lifschitz of Leningrad was recently sentenced to three years for "anti-Soviet slander" and was then transferred to a labor camp in the Kamchatka Peninsula.
