Austria Flunks The Test By Robert E. Segal

Fate plays tricks causing the righteous to weep. The 65,000 Austrian Jews killed by the Nazis and thousands of other Austrians tortured, robbed, and forced to flee during the Holocaust have few to speak for them now while Kurt Waldheim rides in triumph to Austria's presidency by capturing 54% of his nation's votes.

There is no limit to the sordidness of the Waldheim story. But before the 1986 drama fades from memory, an evaluation is in order.

First there must be recall of the evil works of two Austria-born figures of history. They are a turn-of-the-century Mayor of Vienna, Karl Lueger, the sinister leader of the Christian Social Party who taught Hitler how to hate Jews. Hitler, lowly born in Braunau, Austria, near the German border, said of his crafty mentor: "He is the greatest German mayor of all times, a statesman greater than all the so-called diplomats." The more accurate measure of Lueger's statesmanship can be found in a statement he made in 1911: "Jews should be beheaded or hanged, just as long as they are killed." Hitler, to no one's surprise. thought Lueger was too tolerant. Historians credit Lueger with sowing so much Jew-hatred into Austria's civic fabric as to make Austria more anti-Semitic than Germany.

Hitler escaped trial at Nuremberg by giving immolation as his last command and may be burning still in the depths of hell. Three other Austrians -- Adolf Eichman, Arthur Seyss-Inquart, and Hans Rauter -- murderers all, were put to death because of their major roles in carrying out Hitler's final solution.

Israel, naturally, still hopes to bring Waldheim to a courtroom where his career as a Nazi, long kept hidden, can be thoroughly reviewed. Indeed, the United Nations War Crimes Commission concluded 23 years before he became Secretary General of the UN that sufficient evidence existed to prosecute Waldheim in connection with the murder of Yugoslav civilians.

As he settles in as President of Austria, Waldheim has the praise and support of most Austrians convinced the case made against him amounted to slander. Such approbation is not shared by some Austrian intellectuals who have challenged his moral fitness to be president. Even the Austrian media has its bold dissenters. In the Austrian weekly, Profil, these brave lines have bobbed up: "We now appear as a country which elected as President a man who at least lied twice and who, until the very last moment, could not come up with a credible explanation of his past."

Richard von Weizsaecker, President of West Germany, differs sharply with Chancellor Helmut Kohl who now looks upon Waldheim as "a great patriot." Weiszaecker, who fought for Germany in the invasion of Poland, reminds his compatriots and the Austrians that those who close their eyes to the past are blind to the present.

Few national capitals have been heard from. Moscow provides a significant exception. In

Established in 1965 by Jack Tellogoseses words consonant with the spirit of the Nazi-Soviet wartime pact, the Kremlin, with seeming disregard for the fact that 20 million Russians perished when the Nazis were trying for world conquest, has stood tall for Waldheim. Villains in the Austrian presidential campaign, Moscow says, are Washington leaders and Zionists who have shown unjustified hostility to Waldheim.

After all, says the new Austrian President, there was suffering on both sides during World War II. Alas, we heard a similar appeal to reinvent the past when President Reagan, undoubtedly ill-advised by one or more staff members, communicated to the world the shocking observation that the German soldiers interred at Bitburg "were victims, just as surely as the victims in the concentration camps."

Again, words spoken by West German President Richard von Weizsaecker rise in rebuttal: "All of us, whether guilty or not, whether young or old, must accept the past. We are all affected by its consequences and liable for it. The young and old generations must help and can help each other understand why it is vital to keep alive the memories."

Oscar S. Straus, America, Israel And The Fourth
