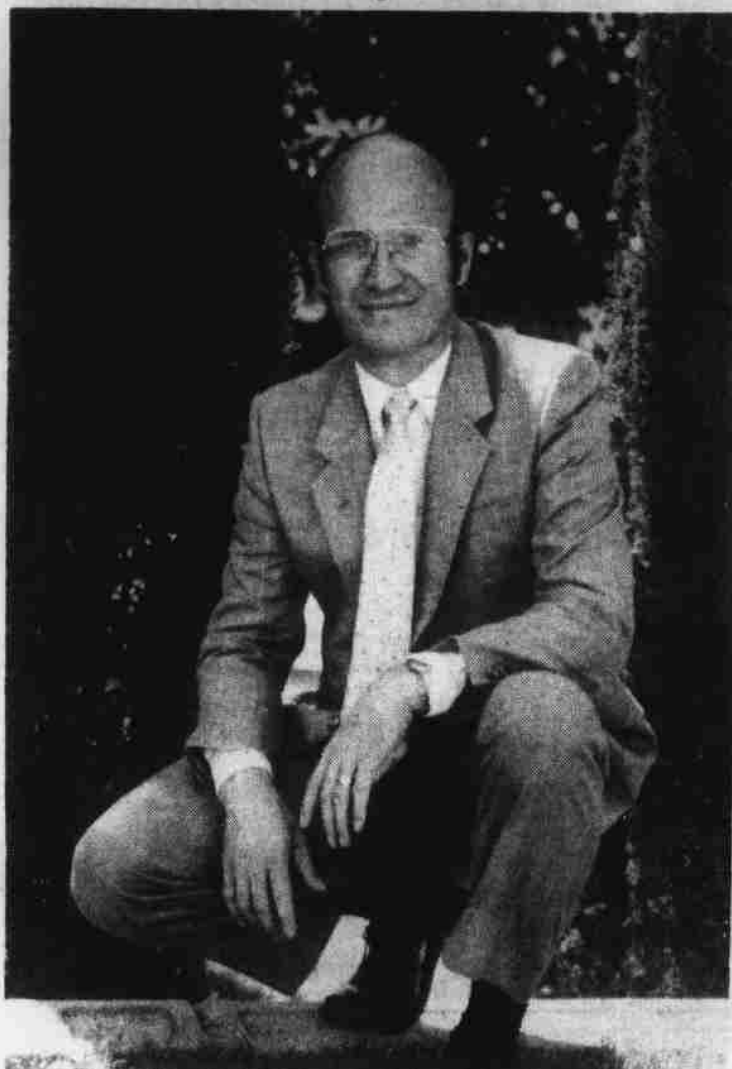


Dennis W. Reber Files For Assembly District 1



Dennis W. Reber has announced he recently filed for State Assembly District 21. District 21 includes most of Henderson (including Green Valley), Logandale, Overton, Mesquite, and Bunkerville.

"I have several key themes to present to the voters during the campaign which I feel are necessary for the 1987 Legislature to address," the Henderson Republican stated. "Quality in education will continue to be stressed, along with funding to insure our children are receiving the best education available."

Economic diversification is needed in District 21 and throughout the state to insure jobs are available to all who want to work should a downturn in the economy occur when a dominant employer is forced to cut back operations. "I don't want to see District 21 voters go through economic strains like residents of Texas and other oil-dependent states are going through with a decline in crude oil prices. I will work to see that the business environment in Nevada is more conducive to industries not necessarily dependent on each other, as we are now dependent on our tourism industry," Mr. Reber indicated.

Mr. Reber mentioned that the Legislature in prior sessions has discussed implementing a state income tax, which he is opposed to. "We

Mr. Reber, a Certified Public Accountant, maintains his practice throughout District 21. "My practice takes me throughout District 21 at least once a week. I believe I understand the needs and concerns of the district voters, I talk with them continually, and I believe I am qualified to serve them in the Legislature. I will represent the district interest first prior to the concerns of other portions of the state. I will represent the district interests and meet with the voters to get their opinions throughout the two-year term and not only at election time."

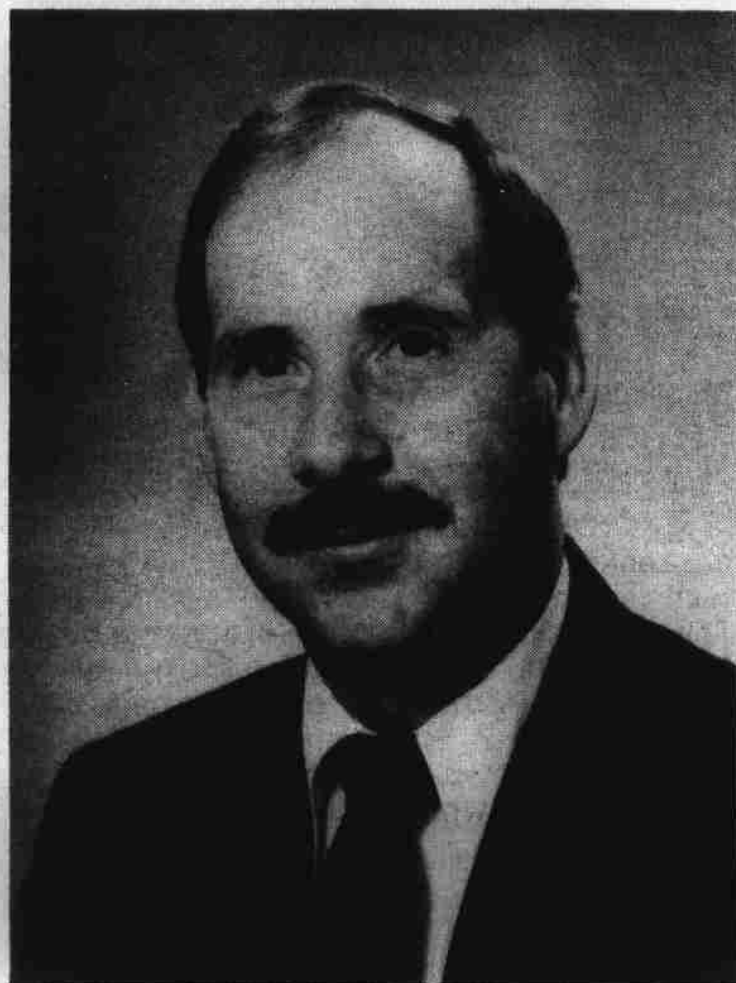
Mr. Reber, his wife Betty, and children, reside at 228 Winona Circle.

Sneddon says, "Spring Valley has not received the representation it should have and we're tired of being a poor orphan in County Government." Sneddon continued, "Cortez has not given us the police substation that we've needed for years."

A Navy veteran, Sneddon has served as Chairman of the Spring Valley Town Advisory Board and served on several committees, including the Clark County Library Bonding and Expansion Steering Committee, the Citizens for Flood Control Steering Committee and the Comprehensive Planning Steering Committee.

A former member of the Las Vegas Jaycees, Sneddon, 47, is a Little League baseball coach, a member of the Harvey Dondero Elementary School P.T.A. and has been active in the Boy Scouts of America for the past ten years.
