'Happy Hooper' Shines In Roaring '20s Revue




Diane Batchelor spins color in Rocky Sennes' "Roaring'20s Revue" creating an unusual act from what was once a Fifties fad.

Billed as the "Happy Hooper," Diane twirls as many as seven gyrating hula hoops on stage nightly except Sunday in the Holiday Casino on the Center Strip.

Her hula hoop career began eight years ago with the Ringling Brothers and Barnum & Bailey Circus. While searching for a novelty routine, the veteran performer chanced upon a group of children playing with hula hoops. She began practicing, first with one hula hoop, then with several. After months of serious practice she unveiled the routine which was to become a regular circus side show for more than one year.

Even with hoops twirling on her arms, neck, legs and waist simultaneously, Diane's the first to admit hula hooping is "not an easy sport." It takes coordination, concentration and skill.
