Bomb Kills 3 Soldiers

Torah vs. Tyranny



Worshippers organized by the Student Struggle for Soviet Jewry read from a Torah scroll at the SSSJ's annual Tisha B'Av prayer service dedicated to the Prisoners of Conscience and refuseniks in the USSR, outside the Soviet UN Mission. The service was led by SSSJ chairman Rabbi Avraham Weiss, who announced that a large-scale rabbinic Operation Redemption -- mass, peaceful arrests -- would take place at the expected Reagan - Gorbachev summit.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Three French soldiers serving with UNIFIL were killed and a fourth wounded when a roadside charge was exploded by remote wire control as they jogged along a road near Joaiya village east of Tyre in southern Lebanon on a physical fitness exercise.

Two of the runners were killed on the spot, while the third died in the UNIFIL hospital at Nakoura. A fifth soldier was unharmed.

The road on which the explosion occurred was used daily for the training.

The attack was the ninth in the area just north of the security zone since the beginning of August.

The deaths of the Frenchmen brings to 21 the number of French UNIFIL members killed in Lebanon, out of the total of 130 UNIFIL deaths.

**'Book Of Abraham,'
Best-Seller On Jewish Theme,
Is Sold For A Record
\$231,000 To Dell Paperbacks**



MAREK HALTER, author of "The Book of Abraham," best-selling epic of Jewish life, just sold to the paperback publisher Dell for \$231,000.

"The Book of Abraham" by Marek Halter, a sweeping epic novel that covers 80 generations of Jewish life over some 2,000 years, has been sold for paperback publication for \$231,000 -- a record sum for a foreign author on a Jewish theme, it was reported this week.

The Dell publishing house, which bought the rights to Halter's bestseller, plans to issue the paperback edition in the Spring of 1987.

Widely praised in Europe, where it was first published, "The Book of Abraham" rose quickly

Netanyahu To Speak At UNLV
Sunday - Sept. 14 - 8 P. M.**

Benjamin Netanyahu, Israel's Ambassador to the United Nations, will be speaking at Artemus Ham Hall, UNLV, on SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, at 8:00 p.m. His visit is part of the Eugene R. Warner Lecture Series bringing internationally distinguished figures to the Las Vegas community in the public interest.

Netanyahu, the youngest Ambassador to represent Israel in the U.N.'s "glass palace" in New York City, is also the first sabra (Israel born) Ambassador to serve in that position. He has already established himself as a forceful and articulate speaker on Israel's behalf, particularly in his passionate attacks on the middle eastern leaders of terrorism and the states that support
