
## Fran Rostov Memorial Service At Congregation Ner Tamid

Over 800 Attend Young Israel Convention Dinner In Israel



The highlight of the historic first convention held by the National Council of Young Israel in Israel this summer was a gala dinner held in the ballroom of the Palace Hotel in Tel Aviv. Almost 800 convention delegates, consisting of representatives of the hundreds of Young Israel synagogues throughout North America and 44 Young Israel synagogues in Israel, gathered to celebrate the achievements of the International Young Israel movement and to hear inspiring words from its president, Harold M. Jacobs, the director of the United Jewish Appeal in Israel, Naftali Lavie, and to enjoy a diverse program featuring the music of the Israeli Army Choir.

Twenty American teenagers participating in the Young Israel sponsored Achva Summer Mission to Israel were in attendance, as well as several busloads of members of Young Israel communities throughout the country, from Chispin in the north, to Beersheva and Gush Khatif in the south, and a sizable contingent from Jerusalem.

The Young Israel leader expressed deep concern over the demographic problems facing the State of Israel, called for new initiatives in response. Specifically, he suggested that special efforts be made to stem the tide of Yordim, Israelis who leave to live in the Diaspora, by seeking them out while they are still in Israel, finding out why they want to leave, and assisting them through loans and counseling, to make it possible for them to stay, as is done in the United States.
