

## Na'Amat USA Sponsoring A Low Cost Trip To Israel To Help Families Celebrate Hanukah In The Jewish Homeland

NA'AMAT USA, The Women's Labor Zionist Organization of America, is sponsoring an eleven-day, nine-night family budget mission to Israel, December 25, 1986 through January 4, 1987, "that is truly a bargain," Rosalie K. Grad of Chicago, Illinois, the group's National Israel Missions Chairwoman, announced today. "Now you can afford to give your family a very special gift, the joy of lighting the Hanukah menorah in Israel," she said.

"The total cost is only \$1,160 per adult for double occupancy in superior and deluxe hotels including the Ramada-Renaissance in Jerusalem, all breakfast and dinner meals, guided tours and round trip air fare on El Al from New York. For children rooming with their parents the cost is only \$920 for each child aged 10-12, and \$1,075 for each child over 12. Children younger than ten cannot be accommodated."

Open to members of NA'AMAT USA, formerly Pioneer Women/Na'amat, the mission will be led by an Israeli tour guide and by Mrs. Grad, who lived in Israel for seven years. Membership in NA'AMAT USA is just \$15 a year.

Participants will be given an opportunity to meet with leaders of the World Zionist Organization. In addition, special prices will be made available to anyone on the mission who wants to extend his/her stay in Israel for up to 180 days. "It is difficult to imagine a more pleasurable way to join hands with our sisters and brothers in Israel than by signing up for this unique trip," Mrs. Grad said. "I am especially pleased to be able to offer American families such a wonderful opportunity to visit our Jewish homeland at an

affordable price."

Additional NA'AMAT USA budget mission to Israel, scheduled for June 28 through July 11, 1987 and December 21, 1987 through January 4, 1988, are now in the planning stages. The organization will also sponsor a "Live and Learn" mission, February 15 through February 25, 1987. ### Pro-PLO East Jerusalem Arab Daily Shut Down

JERUSALEM (WNS) — The military authorities banned distribution of the East Jerusalem Arabic daily Al-Fajr in the administered territories for violation of censorship regulations. The newspaper, which identifies with PLO chief Yasir Arafat, has most of its circulation in the West Bank.

The authorities cited as an extreme example of censorship violation the recent edition of Al-Fajr which published the picture of an Arab woman killed by an Israeli soldier in Hebron after she stabbed another soldier.

The caption was "A Toast for a Killer," in reference to the praise by the commanding officer of the Israeli Central Command for the soldier who shot the woman to save his comrade's life.

The authorities said the restrictions against Al-Fajr would be reconsidered if the editors abide by censorship regulations for a week.

### Reagan: No Invitation For Waldheim

In a letter to thirty-four U.S. Congressmen, the White House stated that President Reagan does not plan to invite Kurt Waldheim to the United States.

"On the President's behalf .... I would like to advise you that there are no plans to extend an official invitation to President Waldheim to visit the United States," the August 7 letter from White House Assistant William Ball to Congressman Bill Green (R-NY) states.

The White House statement was in response to a letter from a bipartisan group of thirty-four Congressmen concerning the "serious implications for United States-Austrian relations" of Waldheim's election as President of Austria.

In April, a secret file at the United Nations was released showing that in 1948 the United Nations War Crimes Commission said Kurt Waldheim should stand trial for "murder" and "putting hostages to death" for his actions as an intelligence officer in the armed forces of Nazi Germany stationed in the Balkans.
