Clark County AIDS cases increased by three during the month of September bringing the total number of cases to 41 since 1981. To date, 25 local patients have died from infections or diseases that occur with a weakened immune system.

Of cases reported, local health officials linked transmission to male homosexual contact in 34 cases, sharing IV drug needles in 3 cases, multiple risk (homosexual intercourse and needle sharing) in 2 cases; no high-risk activity was clearly identified or acknowledged in 2 cases.

The Health District AIDS information number, 383-1393, is open Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Persons who want information about AIDS may call this number for a confidential conversation with a member of the AIDS staff. A national AIDS information number, 1-800-342-AIDS, is available all hours.
