

Steven Spielberg To Receive Scopus Award From American Friends Of The Hebrew University

Steven Spielberg will receive the Scopus Award of the American Friends of the Hebrew University (AFHU) at the 17th annual Scopus Award gala Sunday evening December 14th, at the Century Plaza Hotel.

Richard Dreyfuss will be the Presiding Chairman and Master of Ceremonies.

Announcement of the presentation of the award was made simultaneously in Jerusalem and Los Angeles by Ambassador Avraham Harman, Chancellor of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, and William Weinberg, President of the Western States Region (AFHU).

"The Hebrew University of Jerusalem prides itself on its standards of excellence," Chancellor Harman said. "Steven Spielberg exemplifies that excellence. The name of Steven Spielberg is as much a household word in Jerusalem as it is in

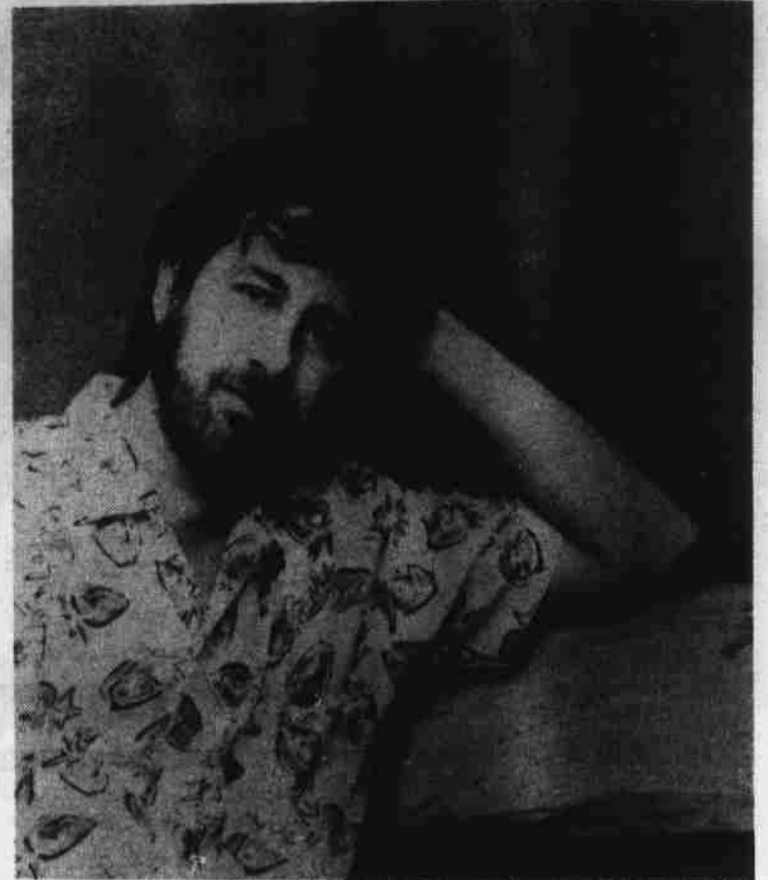
the United States."

In accepting the Scopus Award, Spielberg joins a distinguished list of Americans whose excellence in their chosen profession and humanitarianism have been recognized by supporters of the Hebrew University, world's largest Jewish institution of higher education.

Among them are Nobel Laureate Baruch S. Blumberg, Mayor Dianne Feinstein, President Gerald R. Ford, Betty Ford, Nobel Laureate Milton Friedman, Justice Arthur J. Goldberg, Steve Lawrence and Eydie Gorme, Bob Hope, Dolores Hope, Danny Kaye, Ambassador Jeanne Kirkpatrick, Maestros Mehli Mehta and Zubin Mehta, Dr. Franklin D. Murphy, Gregory Peck, Maestro Gregor Piatigorsky, Nancy Reagan, Maestro Artur Rubinstein, Dinah Shore, Neil Simon, Barbra Streisand, Frank Sinatra, Barbara Sinatra, Peter V. Ueberroth, John Wayne and Elie Wiesel.

Spielberg is the youngest person to be recognized by the University through the Scopus Award which takes its name from the original Mount Scopus campus, the heights overlooking the city of Jerusalem on which Chaim Weizmann set down 12 cornerstones, representing each of the 12 tribes, in 1918. Weizmann later became the first Chairman of the Hebrew University's International Board of Governors and the first President of the State of Israel.

The Cincinnati-born Spielberg, an alumnus of California State University at Long Beach, has emerged as one of the world's most respected and successful filmmakers. He has directed and/or produced seven of the top 20 grossing films of all time. Among them "E.T. - The Extra-Terrestrial," "Jaws," "Close Encounters of the Third Kind," "Raiders of the Lost Ark," "Back to

the Future" and "The Color Purple."

The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, founded in 1918 and formally opened in 1925 by Lord Balfour, former Prime Minister of Great Britain, is the educational home of 17,000 full-time students and 16,000 part-time students of many ethnic and religious backgrounds. They attend classes in 20 faculties and schools and 65 institutes and centers on five campuses - Mount Scopus, humanities; Givat Ram, physical sciences; Ein Karem, healing arts; Rehobot, agriculture; and Eilat, marine biology.

Albert Einstein, Sigmund Freud and Martin Buber were among its founders and were members of its first Board of Governors. Einstein subsequently willed his papers to the University; Buber served on its faculty.

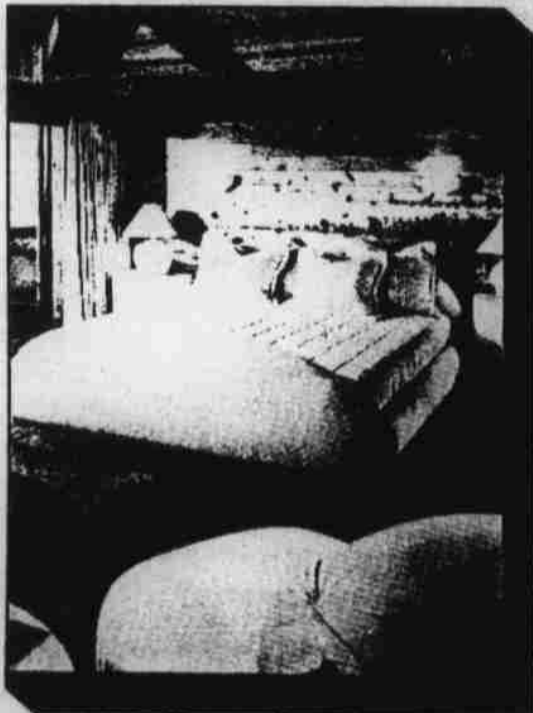
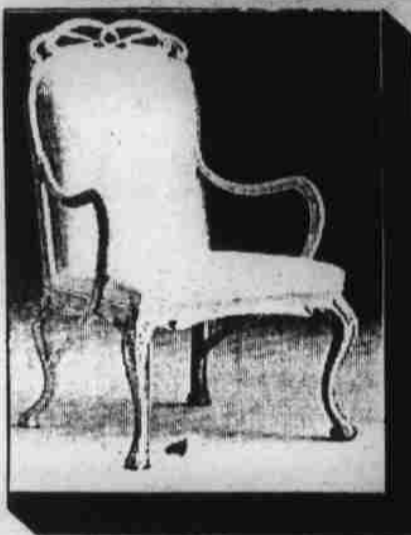
