

Only Italian Restaurant In U.S. Under Kosher Supervision Opens In N.Y.C.

NEW YORK — CHEERS, the only exclusively Italian kosher restaurant in the United States, has been serving capacity crowds since it quietly opened its doors in midtown Manhattan this summer, according to owners Harvey Goldberg and Martin Bodner. The elegantly decorated, bi-level 250-seat dining establishment has been turning away 50 to 60 couples without reservations each night.

"Our dream for many years has been to create the finest Italian restaurant that would appeal in taste and ambiance to those who truly enjoy an

unusual dining experience," said Mr. Bodner. "Frankly, the response has been simply fantastic."

CHEERS features a wide-ranging menu of Italian specialties created, tested and perfected by master chef Robert Stearn, formerly of Gurney's Inn at Montauk and Fraunces Tavern in New York City.

House specialties include fusilli alla putanesca, a dish of tender chunks of chicken stewed in a sauce of tomatoes, olives, capers and garlic served with twists of pasta made on the premises; abbacchio al forno, roasted rack of lamb served with an apple mint sauce; and scaloppine alla francese, veal scallops dipped in egg, sauteed with lemon and chablis.

Both Bodner and Goldberg have enjoyed successful careers in the food and restaurant business before opening CHEERS. Bodner was manager of food operations for major hotels and restaurants. Goldberg was manager for five years of a well-known kosher restaurant in New York City and as president of Schechter Glatt Kosher Tours is connected with the world famous Mount Airy Lodge resort where he caters to more than 1,200 people every Passover.

"We're committed to excellence," said Goldberg. "A varied and high-quality menu, super service, and unequalled ambiance are our primary goals. And while no one is perfect, we're happy that we're able to translate our goals into action."

CHEERS has a staff of eighteen servers, backed up by a kitchen staff of more than two dozen. In addition, a newly-installed computer system provides state-of-the-art inventory control and streamlines the entire operation.

In late Fall, weekend entertainment via a comedy club format is planned.

CHEERS is located at 120 West 41st Street, between 6th Avenue and Broadway, and is open Sunday through Thursday from noon to midnight; Saturday evenings from sundown until 2 a.m. Parking is available from 5 p.m. - 11 p.m. weekdays at a nearby garage. For reservations, call (212) 840-8810.
