Klinghoffer Memorial Forest Visited



lisa (left) and Lisa Klinghoffer paid a recent visit to the Leon and Marilyn Klinghoffer Memorial Forest, established near Jerusalem in memory of their parents by the Jewish National Fund. The 10,000-tree forest serves as a tribute to Leon Klinghoffer, whose brutal murder by terrorists aboard the cruise ship Achille Lauro catapulted him to international attention, as well as to his wife Marilyn, who dedicated the final months of her life to courageously fighting terrorism. The forest is located in the American Independence Park, dedicated during the U.S. Bicentennial by JNF, responsible for afforestation and land reclamation in Israel.
