

Films Planned For Vegas

Sanford International Entertainment, Inc., in conjunction with Sanford Nevada Association Productions, Ltd., is preparing a production schedule concerning major motion pictures, television series programs, video cassette programs and more.

Sanford International Entertainment has recently completed production of "The Eighth Annual Rhythm & Blues Award Show" video taped at Bally's Grand and aired throughout the nation in syndication in August and September of this year.

More recently Sanford International completed a video cassette program for Twin Tower Distributors called "The Secrets of Magic" and

this program went on sale throughout the nation on October 27, 1986.

The President of Sanford International is Jerry Schafer who is also the writer, producer and director of the shows listed above and who, amongst his other responsibilities has recently completed a screenplay entitled "Devil Queen" slated for production in 1987.

B'nai B'rith Lauds Israeli's Peres For Achievements As Prime Minister

WASHINGTON — B'nai B'rith International lauded outgoing Israeli Prime Minister Shimon Peres for his achievements and wished his successor, Yitzhak Shamir, well in meeting his challenges.

In a cable to Israel's highest office, Seymour D. Reich, international president of B'nai B'rith, noting that the Israeli democracy is "again demonstrating its health through an orderly transition to a new government," stated that Peres has left "an impressive legacy."

Reich cited "sound economics, including the lowest inflation in many years, disentanglement from Lebanon, and perhaps most of all, a creative and dogged drive for peace."

The incoming prime minister, said the B'nai B'rith leader, "has inherited a stronger Israel, one with a more secure and respected place in the international community."

Reich noted that there are still "some very serious problems" and mentioned the growing rift between the secular and religious which threatens the very fabric of the Jewish state.

"We wish him well in meeting this and other challenges in the days ahead," declared Reich.
