Plans for the coming year include a number of civic,, governmental and academic events and tributes to David Ben-Gurion. Among them: street namings for Ben-Gurion in New York and other U.S. cities; academic symposiums in major universities throughout the country; and a gala at the Kennedy Center in Washington.

President Reagan has supported this effort from the start, agreeing to serve as honorary chairman of the Committee. A joint Congressional Resolution has been passed recognizing Ben-Gurion's lifetime of accomplishment, and a salute to Israel's founding father was held at The Jewish Museum in New York on October 16.

The year ahead promises even more. Your coverage of David Ben-Gurion's 100th birthday furthers the goals set by the Israeli Parliament last year: to honor and memorialize David Ben-Gurion -- the scholar, the soldier and the seeker of peace.
