Designed for ages 4-8, it features a guide book for parents which includes learning objectives for each game, and background information on all of the holidays. Each boxed game contains 12 full-color boards, symbol sheets, die and instructions. It is available for \$12.95.

A series of Hanukkah puzzles, imported from Israel, features bright colors and large pieces for easy recognition of holiday symbols. The puzzles range in difficulty, from "My First Hanukkah Puzzle," at \$16.95, for ages 2 and up, to "Hanukkah Candle Lighting," at \$7.95, with 16 pieces. Each wooden puzzle was designed by early childhood specialists to promote visual and hand-eye coordination.

For young children, BJE offers a variety of educational books "A Hannukiyah for Dina," shows how a child learns to appreciate Han-

nukah by making her own menorah, while for giftgiving, "My Little Dictionary," features over 500 words colorfully illustrated with Hebrew and English translation.

From the producers of the popular "Animated Haggadah" comes a new color picture book, "The Animated Menorah: Travels on a Space Dreidel," for ages 5-13. Children join "dreidelnauts" on a magic space driedel to discover the traditions of Hanukkah. The book, for \$14.95, features bedtime stories for each night of the holiday.

"Latkes and Hamantashen," is a record album for the entire family that brings to life the characters that symbolize both Hanukkah and Purim in a delightful collection of original holiday songs in English. The songs are designed for singing along, as you learn the stories of the holidays. "Nashir v'Nilmad," a collection of Jewish and American holiday songs, poems, games and stories are designed to develop Hebrew language skills through music.
