Other two-steppers and non-break dancers have a choice of LES BROWN & HIS BAND OF RENOWN in Bally's Grand Ballroom for \$75, or

save some bucks for the tables and casino games by doing the rhythm kix off Route 66 with TOMMY HODGES ORCH in the Sahara Space Center, a dinner dance for \$40, or hop downtown to the Union Plaza for early fireworks display at 8 p.m., followed by a champagne dance to the JOHNNY HAIG ORCH in the Triple Grown Ballroom for only \$17.50.

While at Union Plaza, for another \$60 the corks will pop & sock to "Rock & Roll Forever" with BOBBY RYDELL & THE MARVELETTES, a champagne dinner and favors for \$60. Everything disappears, including the \$55, when illusionists SIEGFRIED & ROY trick customers in "Beyond Belief" at the Frontier, but the rare white tigers actually do appear.

Below \$50 revelers can sigh while PIA ZADORA etches her ballads in the Riviera's Superstar Center with comedian JOEY VILLA for \$49, a midnight dinner with dancing to VINNIE FALCONE'S ORCH, his near-philharmonic outfit backing LA ZADORA as well. But alors! imagine this lissome lass being outpriced in another part of her husband Meshulam Riklis' forest (he owns the joint) with JEFF KUTASH's "Splash" in the showroom for \$55, including champagne buffet. Up-escalator, same hotel, "An Evening at La Cage" prices out at \$29.50, also with champagne buffet.

Nostalgiacs for the long ago's have another choice at the Marina where FREDDIE (BOOM BOOM) CANNON boombooms with the COASTERS in the Marina's ballroom for \$45 in a whoop-de-doo called "50s Rock Out New

Year's Eve." Still more flashbacks flash forward on this night when Sha Na Na disports its stuff & nonsense in the Sahara's Congo Room for \$39.95. And for \$29.95 "Legends in Concert" revives famous star ghosts at Imperial Palace for the early, or midnight show, while the 5th Dimension takes over at 2 a.m. for \$15.

MITZI SHORE trots out a covey of comedians in her Dunes Comedy Store for \$35 complete with champagne. More of the more modestly priced offerings include "Lido de Paris," a spectacular at the Stardust for only \$25; "Minsky's Burlesque" at the Hacienda for \$24.87; the midirevue "Sizzle" in the Sands Copa Room for \$19.95 with some bubbly tossed in; "Playboy's Girls of Rock 'n Roll" at the Maxim for \$20 and the low-priced champ as '86 slides into '87, the KINGSTON TRIO at the Four Queens for \$10.

Golden Nugget horn blowers at midnight will have to be content with games in the marbelized casino rattle ratchets, fling confetti at the dealers, while a private party takes over the Theater Ballroom up-escalator. Boss STEVE WYNN couldn't persuade FRANK SINATRA, his foil in the current funny "high class joint" teevee blurbs to stay over another night. The Chairman of the Board closes out his three-nighter on Dec. 30.
