Manhattan Street To Be Renamed David Ben Gurion Place

NEW YORK (JTA) — An official ceremony will be held in February to rename East 43rd Street between Vanderbilt and Madison Avenues in midtown Manhattan "David Ben Gurion Place" as part of the year-long celebration of the 100th anniversary of Ben Gurion. The street was the site in 1942 of the historic Biltmore Conference at the old Biltmore Hotel where Ben Gurion and other Zionist leaders formally established the goal of a Jewish state.

Mayor Edward Koch signed a bill into law last month renaming the street.

President Chaim Herzog of Israel is the worldwide chairman of the David Ben Gurion

Centennial Committee. Its honorary U.S. chairman is President Reagan.
