JERUSALEM (JTA) — A 26-year-old Palestinian terrorist was sentenced to life imprisonment by a military court in Lod Tuesday for a bomb attack on a Jerusalem bus three years ago that killed six people and injured 50.

Ammar Ibrahim Mahmoud Naame of Abu-Dis village near Jerusalem confessed to planting the bomb on the bus in December 1983. He was arrested only recently for supplying grenades used in an attack on a group of Israeli soldiers and their families near the Western Wall in the Old City.

Authorities said another terrorist who was an accomplice of Naame in the bus bombing will go on trial shortly.
