Wiesel added, "The Presidency is, in the first place, a moral position, and a man with a Nazi past like Waldheim cannot hold an office like that." Waldheim, who · served two terms as United Na-Secretary tions General, was elected to the Presidency of Austria last June 8 by a landslide vote, despite evidence implicating him in atrocities when he served as a Wehrmacht intelligence officer in the Balkans during World War II.
