Auto Journalists Receive Awards From Peers At Imperial Palace

The Third Annual Automotive Journalism Conference was held recently at the Imperial Palace Hotel & Casino in Las Vegas, NV. Two hundred twenty participants attended this year's conference as guests of hotel President/Owner Ralph Engelstad. This represented an increase of nearly 100 percent over the second conference which was held at the Imperial Palace in December, 1985. Next year's conference is expected to surpass the 300 mark.

The conference included two days of informative seminars led by experts in his/her field. The highlight of the two-day conference was an awards banquet and cocktail party compliments of the Imperial Palace on December 11th, at which time "Moto" awards were presented to the winners in each category.

Entrants had submitted their work prior to the conference for judging by a panel of experts in each of seven categories -- newspapers, magazines, newsletters, books, video, television and public relations.

The judges for this year's conference were Dick Van Cleave, public relations; Walter R. Haessner, books; Ronald L. Sessions, video/TV; and Barbara Cloud, Ph.D., printed matter.

Keynote speaker at the awards banquet was Carroll Shelby, auto manufacturer and champion race-car driver. Over the years, Shelby has garnered many awards and is now building a sports car for the '80s -- the Shelby Charger GLH-S two-door hatchback.

The conference was planned with a balance of structured seminars and other activities to give participants a chance to get acquainted with their colleagues -- other publishers, editors, writers, photographers, and industry representatives -- in a casual setting.
