communities.

Trees are planted in every pioneer village as well as army camps in order to screen out the sun, control dust and serve as breaks to protect property, vulnerable field crops and hot houses against land erosion by wind and rain.

JNF also stresses the public care of recreational areas in established mature forests. Every Tu B'Shevat, Independence Day, Pesach and Sukkot, thousands of students distribute trash bags to visitors picnicking in major forests as well as literaturae about prominent archeological and historical attractions to help them form a personal attachment to Israel's rejuvenated forests.

Forests have helped restore much wildlife and flora to the Holy Land. And by replanting the woodlands that covered Israel in the days of the Patriarchs and Matriarchs, JNF is strengthening a living link between modern and historic Israel.

On each Tu B'Shevat, the people of Israel, young and old alike, march from the towns and fields, over mountain and through deserts, toward marshes and sand dunes to plant trees.

They are fulfilling the prophecy of Isaiah 61d:3,4: "And they shall build up the wasted areas, they shall raise up the former desolations, they shall repair the waste cities, the ruins of many generations."

For the rest of the world, the advice of Rabbi Yochanan Ben Zakkai still holds: "If you should have a sapling in your hand and be suddenly told the Messiah has come, plant the sapling first and afterwards go welcome the Messiah!"
