JERUSALEM (JTA) — The Israel Navy intercepted a merchant ship bound from Cyprus to Lebanon and seized 50 El Fatah terrorists on board. A senior Naval oficer said that the action clearly averted a series of terrorist attacks and sabotage attempts against Israel.

The 400-ton Maria R., which flew the Honduran flag and is owned in Lebanon, was en route from Larnaca to Khalde in Lebanon, It was halted about 65 miles from the coast because it appeared to be carrying far more people than the
