Enrollment at UNLV for Spring Semester 1987 has hit 12,148 -- an increase of 5.1 percent over last spring -- according to preliminary, unofficial figures released by the Registrar's Office Wednesday.

Last spring's final headcount was 11,555. The preliminary count for this spring shows an increase of 593 full-time and part-time students attending the university, according to Registrar Jeff Halverson.
