New Jersey Sues Hotel Over Kashrut

- The office of State Attorney General W. Cary Edwards has filed civil complaint seeking a \$75,000 fine

NEWARK, N.J. (JTA) against an Asbury Park hotel for claiming to comply with state kashrut regulations despite agreeing last year to drop the claim.

Asbury The Metropolitan Hotel Co., formerly the Metro politan Hotel/Motel, and owners Martin Weinblatt and Sylvia Weinblatt violated the pledge to drop the claim at least three times, according to the Monmouth County Superior Court.

The state Kosher Enforcement Bureau found non-kosher foods and meats in the hotel September 30, 1986, the company had signed a consent

LONDON (JTA) -Three members of Parliament dropped their plans to fly to Moscow to attend a reception at the British Embassy for losif Begun and other leading Jewish refuseniks. The Soviet authorities refused to grant them visas.

The three MPs are Lord James Douglas-Hamilton and Dame Peggy Fenner, Conservatives, and Laborite Greville Janner, All are members of the Parliamentary Committee for the Release of Soviet Jewry. They were informed by the Foreign Office that there would be problems over their admission.
