National Chess Open Is International Event At Imperial Palace Hotel & Casino

Many of the world's greatest chess players will be coming to the Imperial Palace Hotel & Casino in March to participate in the 1987 National Open Chess Tournament. The tournament is to be held March 13-15 and is being promoted as the largest tournament in the United States. The \$20,000 prize fund is a record purse for this event.

Over 750 competitors and 12 to 15 computer entries will do silent battle in the Royal Halls on the third floor of the Imperial Palace. The tournament is a "6 Round Swiss" with players advancing to face ever more brilliant strategists until only two are left. Competition begins Friday, March 13th at 12:30 p.m. Second round is Friday night at 7:30 p.m. Saturday's rounds begin at 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. On Sunday the narrowed field makes their opening moves at 10:00 a.m. The final round begins at 4:00 p.m. Sunday and is expected to end at approximately midnight.

Although it is theoretically possible an "unknown" could advance to the finals, the final rounds will pit the Grand Masters (GMs) and International Grand Masters (IMs) against each other.

Grand Masters from all over the world will be attending this prestigious event representing over 15 different countries. Among those attending are recent Soviet chess champion, Boris Gulko, Canadian chess champ, G.M. Igor Ivanov, Israeli G.M. Yehuda Gruenfeld, U.S. junior champ, G.M. Maxim Dlugy, G.M. Dmitri Gurevich and G.M. Sergey Kudrin. Also competing will be G.M. Maria Ivanka, who was on the Hungarian team on Board #1 (second behind the Russian team) in the 65-Nation Chess Olympaid played three months ago in Dubai, Arab Emerates. Other famous players include United States champs, G.M. Arthur Bisquier and G.M. Walter Browne.

An added bonus on Thursday evening, March 12th, will be a free exhibition of a three-game grudge match between this year's U.S. champ, Murillo & Ulises In "Splash"
