## ONTRY in VEGAS

The Miracle Ear Center, Las Vegas, in conjunction with Dr. Dennis Bealick, medical ear specialist, joined the nationwide network of "Dial A Hearing Screening Test" systems. This system provides a preliminary hearing screening test over the telephone with pertinent follow-up information for those who call.

"Dial A Hearing Screening Test" ("DAHST") is a two minute recorded message which introduces four faint tones for each ear. The system can be called seven days a week, 24 hours a day. There are no special charges for the call, so it is recommended to call a second time to verify the results. For best accuracy, calls should be placed from a quiet room using a good quality telephone.

The "DAHST" program was developed in 1983 to increase hearing health awareness and assist in early detection of hearing loss. There are an estimated 46,180 people in Clark County with communicative disorders. Many have not sought corrective assistance due to a lack of information, fear, vanity or misinformation.
