Six new cases of acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS) and two more deaths were reported to public health officials during February. The number of cases reported since 1981 totals 58; of those, 37 patients have died.

In all new cases reported, the virus was acquired through high-risk activities.

An informational hotline, 383-1383, is open 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the Health District. Anyone who wants more information about AIDS or services available to persons infected with the AIDS virus may call the hotline. All conversations are confidential. A national AIDS information number, 1-800-342-AIDS, is available 24 hours a day.

Persons who wish to volunteer time or assistance to AIDS patients in Clark County may contact Aid for AIDS of Nevada (AFAN), 369-6162.
