provide and maintain continued stability.

"Las Vegas continues to be a focal point of national and worldwide interest and publicity," Dondero said, "It's critical that we have an officer who can work full-time at representing the city's top executive position with commitment and open-mindedness to the future. Las Vegas can't afford to be dormant with so much attention focused on it. I feel I'm the person who realistically can keep our local government operating smoothly so the city as a whole can continue to progress and prosper."

A long-time resident of Las Vegas, Dondero is a founding member of the Secret Witness Program, and has actively contributed to the program through her support of the \$6.2 million Metro Communications Center Bond issue and \$1.2 million for the Metro Fingerprint System.

She also helped establish drug aversion and gang-related preventive programs, and backed an ordinance requiring an FBI fingerprint check of all childcare providers.

Dondero has worked successfully to reduce tax rates in Winchester and Paradise Townships by supporting state legislation to provide for tax

parity among the urban towns, and her efforts to roll back county tax rates for Winchester and Paradise in 1983 resulted in a \$2 million tax savings for the residents of the townships.

Dondero currently is chairman of the Las Vegas Valley Water District and a member of the Board of Trustees for University Medical Center. She was appointed by Governor Richard Bryan to the Nuclear Waste Commission and the Senior Citizens Advisory Board, and is a member of the Nevada Development Authority (and chairman of NDA's Nevada Development Coordinating Committee) and a former member of the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority.
