Indy JCRC Informs Soviet Coach Of Its Concern For Oppressed Peoples

NEW YORK (JTA) — When the Soviet track and field team came to town last week, the Indianapolis (Ind.) Jewish Community Relations Council (JCRC) couldn't pass up the opportunity to relay a message to Soviet officials about its concern for Soviet Jews and other oppressed Soviet peoples.

Board member Pete Strong, who was in-

involved in local hospitality for the participants in the World Indoor Championships, sought to hand a letter expressing both brotherhood and concern to the Soviet coach, Igor Ter-Ovansesyan.

He couldn't find the coach, but Yvgeny Malkov, who identified himself as a Soviet journalist, accepted the letter and kibitzed briefly, Strong said.

Two days later, Malkov appeared unannounced at Strong's office, saying that the coach was busy, but would meet Strong for lunch. The meeting never took place, and Strong admitted arriving a tad late for the appointment.

Nevertheless, Strong felt the JCRC's point was made. "Indianapolis is in the heartland, and we were sensitive to making forceful kinds of confrontation here," he said. "I do feel that they got the message loud and clear."
