Incidents such as that in Howard Beach have illustrated the fact that while great progress has been made in civil rights, and the nation has evolved into a non-racist society, there continue to be "vast pockets of racism," making it imperative that efforts to advance civil rights not be allowed to falter.

The constitutional principle of churchstate separation must also be "drastically and passionately reaffirmed," Wieseltier said.

"That is not to say that religion should be banned from the private realm, but it is of absolute importance that religion be kept out of the public realm.


