From Computer Programs To Children's Puzzles: BJE Offers Educational Gifts For Passover

On April 13 at sundown, Jewish families around the world will gather for the Seder, the traditional Passover meal, to retell the story of the exodus from Egypt and retrace their Jewish roots. In many families, in order to retain the interest of young children at the meal, it is customary for the children to "steal" a piece of matzah, and hold it for ransom in exchange for a

Jewish parents looking for an appropriate Passover present for their children, or when

visiting families for the Seder, can turn to the Board of Jewish Education of Greater New York for help. BJE, in keeping with the historical spirit of the holiday, offers a variety of Jewish educational materials and gifts for children and adults. BJE accepts orders anywhere in the U.S. and Canada and can ship items in time for Passover.

"Harakevet," (the Train) a computer program for beginning readers, teaches the recognition of the Hebrew and English alphabets and the relationship between letters and words through creative graphics and sound effects. "Shalshelet," (the Chain) a program for more advanced readers, improves Hebrew comprehension and vocabulary through stories and puzzles. Both programs are Apple-compatible and were produced by BJE.

Other items available for children include: the "Animated Haggadah" and the Animated Haggadah Video, which relate the story of Passover through clay animation; "Mostly Matzah," a collection of traditional Passover songs in English and Hebrew, available on record or cassette; and wooden puzzles from Israel depicting Passover rituals such as the Seder night and the search for leaven.

For adults, the Speyer Haggadah is an illuminated reproduction of original 14th century haggadahs and includes text in Hebrew and English. A collector's item, it is available for under \$45.

BJE also offers holiday videos, among them "Ha-Afikomen," an animated film that takes you into the home of a family as they prepare and participate in the Passover Seder. The film includes the blessings over the candles and the matzah, the four questions and Passover songs. Cost for the video and guide is \$29.95.

Anti-Semitism In Austria

VIENNA (JTA) - A survey conducted by Austria's four major opinion poll institutes showed that seven out of every 100 Austrians are self-declared anti-Semites. The survey of a cross-section of the population, totalling 9,000 people, sponsored by the Austrian National Bank, showed that the lowest rate of anti-Semitism -- four percent -- was in the 14-29-year age group and the highest among those over 60.

Only three percent among those with higher education had anti-Semitic feelings.
