Rabbi Menitoff's unique career of public service includes work in a Harlem settlement house, volunteer Hebrew teaching of immigrants to the State of Israel, the development and implementation of an educational enrichment program for the children of the Chippewa Indian Tribe in Northern Wisconsin, and the 1985 Columbus House Emergency Night Shelter Volunteer Service Award "for enabling homeless men and women to receive shelter, food, and companionship necessary to protect their lives and preserve their dignity." He is perhaps best known in his former habitat of Southern California where he spent the first 15 years of his rabbinate as host of KABC-TV's popular weekly series "Rap with Rabbi Mike."


