Any surplus will be donated to the City of Hope and/or other designated major charitable organizations. Larson, a former City of Hope "Man of the Year," said, "We hope this will spur others to help Valerie." The girl's mother, Ayako, is a changeperson at the Silver City casino, another Circus Circus Enterprises, Inc., property. Her father, Bob, works for the Post Office.

The Brandeis-Bardin Institute offers a wide variety of Jewish programming, including Camp Alonim, a youth summer camp for ages 8-16; BCI, a month long summer leadership program for men and women ages 18-26; and House of the Book week-ends, featuring scholars-in-residence who explore current Jewish issues and allow the participants to share in a very special weekend Shabbat experience.
