

Hebrew University Students Ask Gorbachev To Release Raoul Wallenberg For Dinner In His Honor On May 11

JERUSALEM — A group of American students at the Rothberg School for Overseas Students of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem have written to Soviet leader Michail Gorbachev asking him to allow Raoul Wallenberg to attend a dinner to be given in his honor May 11 at the Hebrew University.

Wallenberg is the Swedish diplomat who, at great personal peril, devoted himself to the rescue of Jews from the Nazis in Hungary during World War II. He was arrested by the Soviets when they liberated the country from the Nazis and has not been seen in the West since. There are still hopes that he may yet be alive under Soviet detention.

The eight students who are arranging the dinner and who have written (in Russian) to Gorbachev are in a special one-year program at the Rothberg School known as the Raoul Wallenberg Scholarship Program. The students engage in regular studies at the Rothberg School, with the addition of a special seminar on problems of leadership in contemporary democracy taught by Hebrew University Political Scientist Dr. Yaron Ezrahi. Meetings with Israeli political and other public figures also are part of the program.

Herzog On His Way To West Germany
