The Allante' was presented to The Boyd Group (owners of the Stardust) by Cashman Cadillac, and can be won on a special dollar slot carousel at the resort.

The Stardust, long famous for its varied and unusual slot giveaways, in addition to the multitude of cash winners on its 1,200 machines, is also currently offering slot jackpots that include a mink jacket, diamond ring, gold, classic Ford Mustang, Honda Spree, Corvette, customized van, and 4-wheeler.

Since 1985, automobile winners from Stardust slot play have more than tripled, with year-to-date figures indicating that even more autos will be given away this year.

The Allante', Cadillac's entry into the ultraluxury grand touring car class, is designed and built by Pininfarina, of Turin, Italy, the same famous style house that has produced the Farrari Testarossa and Rolls-Royce Camargue. It has been transported from Italy on "Airbridge," a special Boeing 747 craft.

Industry firsts include an AM/FM cellular telephone power antenna (retractable), and tilt-and-telescope, leather wrapped steering wheel. The Allante' also features the Bosch III Anti-lock braking system, its first use in a production automobile.

The \$50,000 value of the Allante' makes it one of the largest slot prizes ever offered by the Stardust.
