A Soviet Foreign Ministry spokesman was quoted as saying there were no arrangements for a larger number of exit permits to be granted and that no invitation has been sent to Israeli Foreign Minister Shimon Peres to visit Moscow.

According to reports from Moscow, Soviet Foreign Ministry spokesman Gennadi Gerasimov said, "We cannot guarantee an exact number of applications that can be presented and receive favorable outcomes," a reference to reports that 11,000 - 12,000 Soviet Jews would be permitted to leave in the next 9 - 12 months. "There will be no quotas," he said.

Peres told Israel Radio that he hadn't heard of any invitation. "There may be such intentions but
