TEL AVIV (JTA) — Traffic accidents took a heavy toll Sunday. Twenty-one people were injured when a truck slammed into a bus at a highway intersection near Ashkelon. All were hospitalized. Only one passenger was seriously hurt.

NEW YORK (JTA) — Two American Jewish leaders returned Sunday from a three-day visit to Moscow during which they met with high government and Communist Party officials for what they described as a "candid discussion on the subject of Soviet Jews in all of its aspects." They said they were optimistic.

They stated that while they were satisfied with the mood in the streets, and tone of their discussions, "it would not be productive at this time to go into details." They agreed that "events of the next few months will tell whether the optimistic mood in which we returned is justified."

NEW YORK (JTA) — The Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith is accepting 16 mm film and 3/4-inch video entries on human relations themes for the 1987 Dore Schary Awards for human relations films and videos by college students.

The 1985-award winner, "Debonair Dancers" by Allison Nigh-Strech of Santa Barbara, Calif., has been nominated for an Academy Award in the short documentary category.


WASHINGTON (JTA) — Legislation to investigate how Nazi criminals were allowed into the United States has been introduced in Congress. The bill, sponsored by Rep. Barney Frank (D. Mass.), would establish a seven-member Commission selected by Congress and the President which would enjoy special subpoena powers giving it access to evidence and testimony from the various intelligence agencies. The commission would issue a report on its findings of smuggling of Nazis by U.S. intelligence agents and recommendations.

Frank proposed legislation after the completion of a second General Accounting Office (GAO) report on the subject which concluded that there was "no evidence of a broad program to recruit former Nazis for intelligence." Frank, Brooklyn District Attorney Elizabeth Holtzman and Jewish leaders attacked the report, the second produced within seven years, for being misleading and inconclusive.

BEERSHEBA (JTA) — A team of 30 athletes from the University of Warsaw will participate in the 19th International Student Sport Games, April 26 - May 3, hosted by Gen Gurion University. This marks the first appearance of a Polish team in the tournament which will include approximately 1,000 athletes from Brazil, Switzerland, Germany, England and Israel. Held annually, the games are organized by the Academic Sport Association in Tel Aviv.

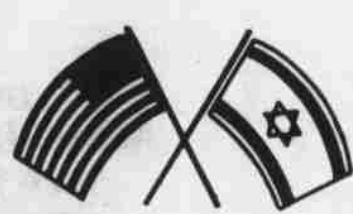
